After graduating from the Istanbul Technical University, Faculty of Civil Engineering, Metin ARSLAN completed his doctorate studies on engineering and economics in the US, in the field of infrastructure systems planning/management and economic impact. He gave lectures on Logic and Scientific Method, Philosophy of Physics and Social Sciences and System Analysis/Fluid Mechanics, and he consulted on the subjects of economic models and country risk. Between 1994 and 2007, he worked as a faculty member in the Hacettepe University Department of Economics. Between 2007 and 2013, he served as a political advisor in the State Planning Organization and the Ministry of Development.

His area of interest and published interdisciplinary studies include multi-source impact analysis/information theory, as well as economic thought, social/physical sciences/mathematics/philosophy and methodology of logic, modeling, emerging paradigms and postmodern discussions.
